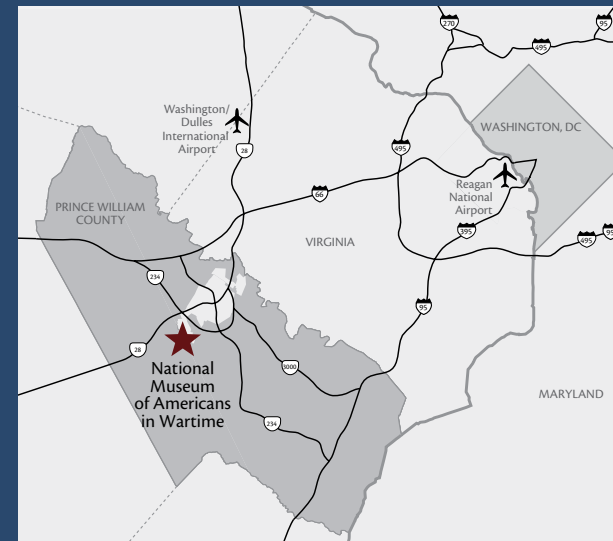

### A UNIQUE CONCEPT

**THIS WILL BE THE ONLY** national military museum to cover comprehensively:

- All military branches—Army, Navy, Marine Corps, Air Force, and Coast Guard and their corresponding units of the Reserves and National Guard.
- All major conflicts of the 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> centuries—World War I, World War II, Korea, Vietnam, Desert Storm, Afghanistan, and Iraq.
- Personal experiences of those who served on both the battlefield and home front by telling how ordinary Americans did extraordinary things to protect our freedoms and the home front.

- Enjoy military air shows staged at a nearby airport.
- Pilot a jet fighter or command a nuclear aircraft carrier in training simulators used by Naval and Air Force personnel.
- Learn firsthand about wartime experiences from veterans serving as tour guides.
